

## WVGCSA WILLICAM C. CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP & RESEARCH FUND

Mr. William C. Campbell is one of the greatest amateur golfers to ever play the game. His winning record includes the Mexican Amateur (1956), U.S. Amateur (1964), Ontario Amateur (1967), U.S. Senior Amateur (1979-1980), three WV Open's and 15 WV Amateur's. He has finished runner-up in the U.S. Open and British Amateur, and has played in 37 U.S. Amateur's, 15 U.S. Open's and 18 Master's. He has been a member of eight Walker Cup teams (Captain 1956) and is undefeated in eight singles matches.

As an ambassador and volunteer to the game, Mr. Campbell is the only American to serve as both President of the United States Golf Association and Captain of the Royal & Ancient Club of St. Andrews, the two primary governing bodies of golf for the world. In 2009, Mr. Campbell was inducted into the West Virginia Golf Hall of Fame as one of its inaugural members.

All applications will be screened and selected by the WVGCSA Board of Directors. The decision for successful applicants will rest solely with the Board of Directors and their decision will be final.

Applications must be received by May 15<sup>th</sup> of the applicable year to be considered for the fall semester and October 15<sup>th</sup> of the applicable year to be considered for the spring semester. Notification to successful candidates will occur no later than August 1<sup>st</sup> and presentation of awards will be during the first two weeks of August. Recipients will be asked to attend a luncheon to receive the award and meet with the WVGCSA Board of Directors.

### Student Criteria

- Current golf course employee and member in good standing with the West Virginia Golf Course Superintendents Association.
- Be a person who exemplifies good moral character.
- Financial need is not a factor in the selection process.
- Must have been accepted to a University, College, Vocational School or other post high school educational institution to obtain a turfgrass degree.
- A recipient may be considered for succeeding awards. However, such recipient shall provide the WVGCSA Board of Directors with a narrative of his or her educational pursuits for the previous year and a transcript of grades from the previous year. Grade point average must remain 2.5 or above to be considered. A new application will be necessary each year. All applicants will be considered equally each year.
- The award amount will be \$1500.00 to be paid \$750.00 per semester (adjusted on quarter system).
- We would encourage former recipients of this award to contribute back to the fund if and when he or she were able to, so perhaps more young people could be helped by the Association. This is not a requirement.
- Applicants will be evaluated on academic achievement, extracurricular, community involvement, leadership and outside employment. Applicant shall complete an original
