

West Virginia Junior Player of the Year

Each year the West Virginia Junior Player of the Year receives the Jim Ward Trophy. Jim Ward has been an ambassador for junior golf in West Virginia for over 30 years. His record as an amateur golfer is extraordinary. Jim Ward was a schoolteacher from Huntington that won the 1964 West Virginia Amateur; he defeated A.J. Gray 2&1 in the final match. It was the first time since 1941 that someone other than Bill Campbell or Ed Tutwiler had won the West Virginia Amateur. Before 1976, junior golf in West Virginia was virtually nonexistent. Jim Ward noticed this problem and, with the help of Larry Martin, started the West Virginia Junior Amateur in 1976, which was played at Parkersburg Country Club.
