

## West Virginia Golf Association Residency Policy

**DEFINITION OF RESIDENT:** A player's true, fixed permanent home and place of habitation

**ACTIVE MEMBER:** One who is dues paying at a WVGA Type I, II or III Club

**DEFINITION OF REGULAR MEMBER:**

- 1) Must be an active member of the West Virginia Golf Association
- 2) Play more than 50% of their rounds of golf at a Type I Member Club
- 3) Must post at least 10 rounds of golf in a calendar year

Residency and / or membership status shall be determined by the Executive Director. The Executive Director is authorized to request such written documents, verifications, or other evidence as is deemed necessary to establish the Residency and / or membership status of a player. The burden of establishing residency and / or membership status for the WVGA tournaments and events is upon the player.

**PLAYERS RIGHT TO APPEAL RESIDENCY DECISION**

In the event a player wishes to appeal the Executive Directors decision, the player shall file a written appeal to the Championship Committee within five days of the date of notification of the decision with supporting documentation of his/her Residency and / or membership status. Such a written appeal shall include a written account as to why the player is deemed a resident under this policy. All written appeals shall be forwarded to the Championship Committee, 1 Frances P Jordon Way, Charleston, WV 25302, or by facsimile transmission to (304)391-5050 at the attention of Dave Pope, Championship Chairman.

The Championship Committee shall be composed of at least three members of the Executive Committee. The player will be notified of the date when such appeal will be heard. Failure of the player to attend the hearing in person or by phone call shall not preclude a final decision by the Championship Committee. The Championship Committee will issue a written decision.
